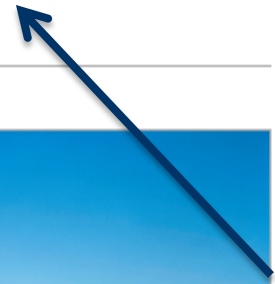

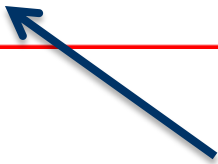

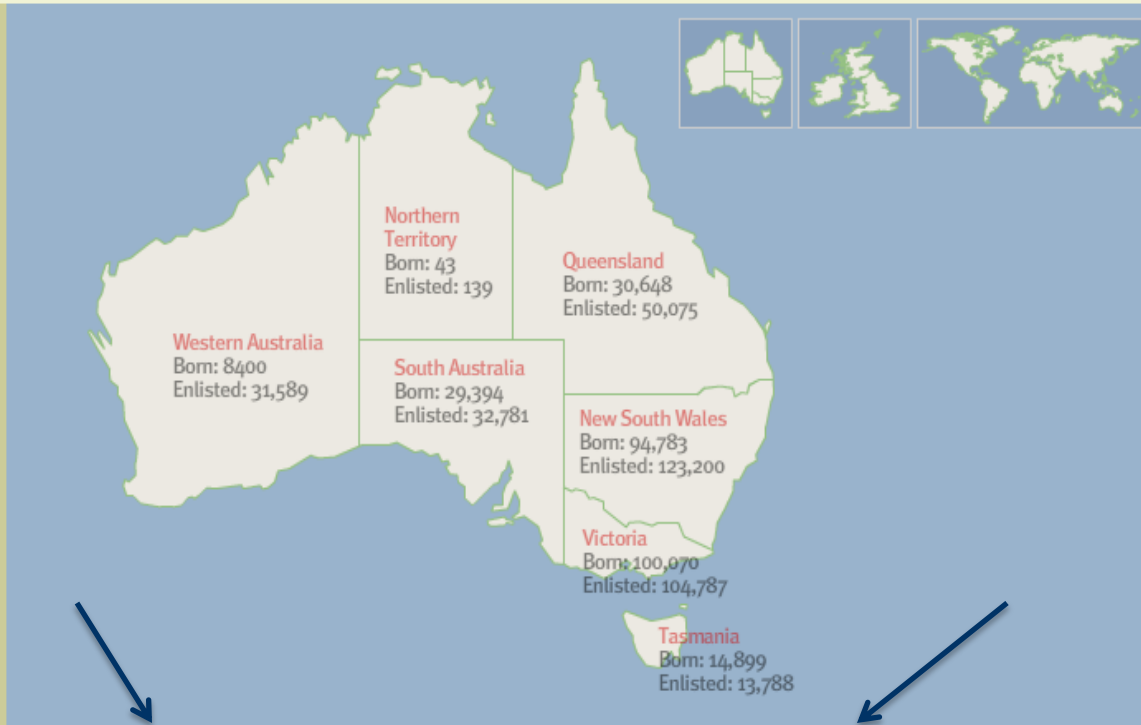

- [Pretymen Index](#) - For information about the origins of Tasmanian place names.
- [Wayn Index](#) - An index to colonial Tasmanian Government records and colonial newspapers compiled by Amelia Lucy Wayn during the period from the 1920s to 1940s.

- [Whitfeld Index](#) - A selective index of personal names found in Tasmanian colonial newspapers, 1816-1900. There are a few entries for the years after 1900. The main emphasis is on the names of members of early settler and eminent families, though the scope is sometimes wider. The main data recorded are for births, deaths and marriages, wills and bequests, land grants and property sales. There is a small subsection of topical and geographic subject entries. Mostly applicable to Northern Tasmania.
- [Artists Index](#) - An index of Tasmanian visual artists (not including craftspeople) represented in one-person and group exhibitions of which catalogues (some of which remain uncatalogued) are held in the TAHO collection.

Other items

Tasmanian Film and Video Database

Provides descriptive information about films and videos produced by or for Tasmanian government organisations and some private individuals. Items from government sources include footage of Tasmanian places and events, training films, promotional / documentary material and some cinema release feature films. Material deposited by private individuals includes amateur productions and documentaries, and 'home movies' showing life, events and places in Tasmania.

Name indexes

Search name indexes

- **Arrivals** - index of passengers and ships arriving, mainly in Hobart
- **Census index** - index of people (householders) in the 1840s and 1850s
- **Colonial Tasmanian Family Links database** - is not a direct index to records but contains a large amount of information **(not necessarily verified)** about Tasmanian families
- **Convict applications for permission to marry** - index of convicts applying to marry free people or other convicts
- **Departures** - index of people leaving Tasmanian ports
- **Divorces** - index of people getting divorced up to 1920
- **General index** - index of contents of a range of records, mainly names, but some subjects
- **Inquests** - index of records of inquests into people's deaths from the 1820s to the 1920s - inquests into fires are indexed in the 'general index'
- **Naturalisations** - index of people applying to become citizens up to 1904
- **Tasmanian convicts** - index of all convicts transported to Tasmania and those convicted locally through the convict system
- **Wills** - index of wills and letters of administration of estates registered for probate

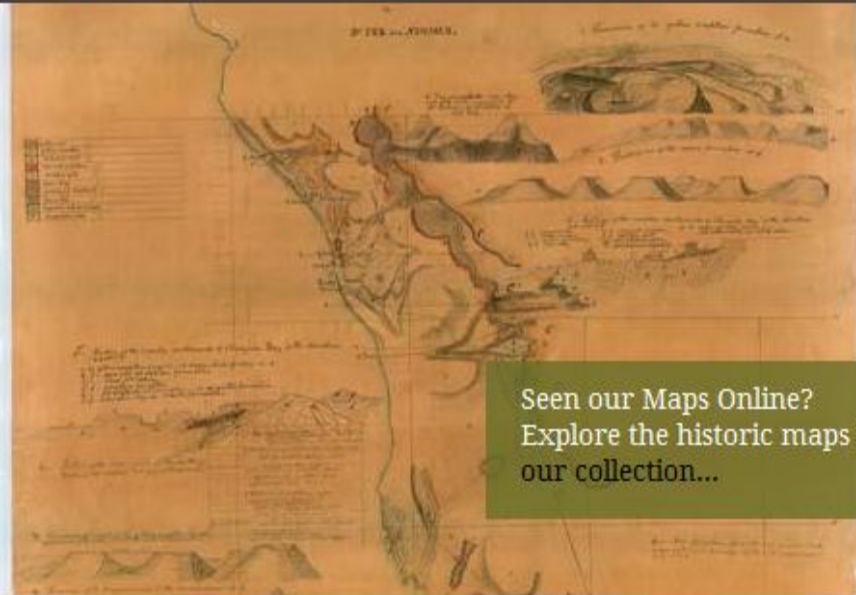

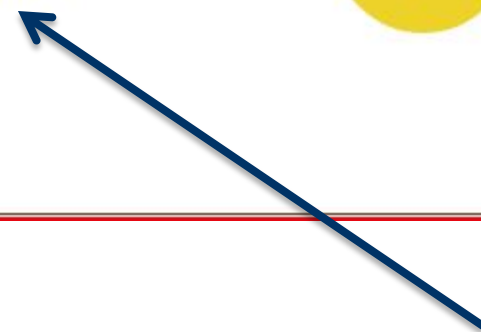

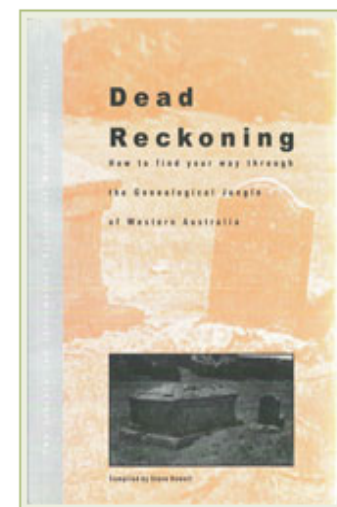

Dead Reckoning: how to find your way through the Genealogical Jungle of Western Australia (compiled by Steve Howell) was first published in 1997. It was an update of the 1983 Library Board of Western Australia publication: [Tracing your ancestors: a guide to genealogical sources in the J.S. Battye Library of West Australian History](#).

Since 1997, the Battye Library and the State Records Office have received new material of interest to anyone undertaking genealogical and biographical research. As well, many relevant internet resources have been developed. Following a grant from the Sholl Bequest (administered by the Friends of Battye Library Inc.), it was decided to revise and publish the book online, so it can be regularly updated as appropriate resources and material are found.

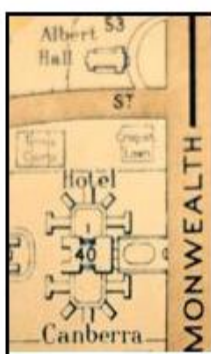

The Assessment Books record details of ownership, occupation, construction, and value for property in the City of Sydney between 1845 and 1948. They provide valuable information for family and property history which is not available from any other source.

- ◆ Online catalogues rarely at detailed item level
- ◆ Still need research trips to archives and time to search the records
