Family history

Starting your research

The Library's collections offer a wealth of resources to the Australian family historian.

You will find most family history material on microfiche and microfilm in a special area of the Newspapers and Microforms Reading Room. Check our guide to [Family history sources in the Newspapers and Microforms Reading Room](#) to see what we hold.

Staff can help you locate resources and use the microform equipment, but cannot do extensive or ongoing genealogical, historical or other research for you.

You can search the Library's [catalogue](#) for specific topics, such as published family histories, local histories, ship information and biography.

Check [eResources](#) for our many online resources relating to family history. Some of these you need to come to the Library's [reading rooms](#) to use.

Try both 'family history' and 'genealogy' when searching as both these terms are often used.

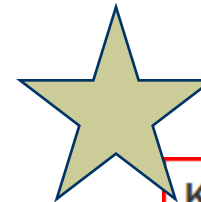

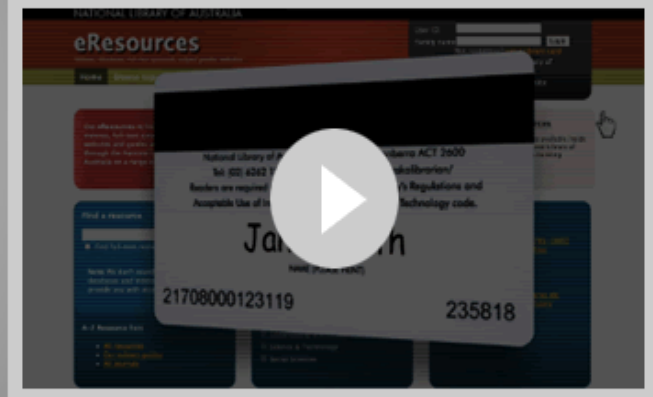

1. [Old Register: one to nine: the registers of assignments and other legal instruments \(NSW\)](#)

 State Records NSW: This is a new Index to the nine old Registers created to record land transactions, and much more, in New South Wales between 1802 and 1824. The Index has been compiled from copies of the original nine Registers in the custody of the Registrar General and includes many previously unindexed entries. The "Old Register" was transferred from the Department of Lands to State Records NSW in 2008. They form the series NRS 5604, Register of Assignments and other Legal Instruments, 6 March 1802-15 May 1824

2. [Free passengers to NSW 1826-1837](#)

 Society of Australian Genealogists: Contains a searchable database of 36,000 names of free passengers, crews & military arriving by passenger, merchant or whaling vessels to New South Wales between 1826 and 1837.

3. [Index to Colonial movements 1827-1853](#)

 Descendants of Convicts' Group, Inc: Index to approximately 10,000 convict movements in the Colony of New South Wales (covering present day New South Wales, Queensland, Tasmania and Victoria. Entries comprise convict's names or alias, the date of the movement, and the place from which the convict was moved.

UNSW ADFA: This searchable database provides details on the 330,000 men and women who served overseas in the (First) Australian Imperial Force, 1914-1918. Information has been gathered from a variety of sources.

30. [Census of Ireland 1911](#)

National Archives of Ireland: This site provides the household returns and ancillary records of the 1911 census of Ireland. A name index, transcripts and digitised images are provided and you may also browse the census returns by street. Coverage for all counties is not yet complete.

14. [Eighteenth Century Journals: Newspapers and Periodicals 1685-1815](#)

 Adam Matthews: This service brings together rare journals printed between 1685 and 1815, illuminating all aspects of eighteenth-century social, political and literary life. Many are ephemeral, lasting only for a handful of issues, others run for several years. Topics covered are extremely wide-ranging and include: colonial life; provincial and rural affairs; the French and American revolutions; reviews of literature and fashion throughout Europe; political debates; and London coffee house gossip and discussion. The titles chosen have been screened carefully against other eighteenth century resources (many available at the National Library of Australia) to ensure minimal overlap. Available for document delivery to Australian libraries.

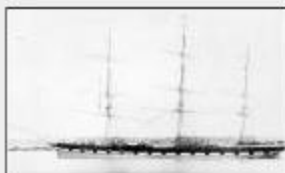

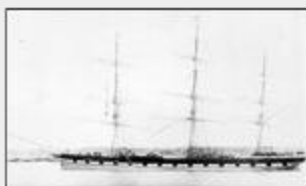

THE WOMEN'S VOLUNTARY NATIONAL REGISTER

by Shauna Hicks

Ms Shauna Hicks, a Librarian at John Oxley Library and Convenor of the Queensland Branch of the Society of Australian Archivists has done extensive genealogical research in Queensland.

The Women's Voluntary National Register was an official record of the names of women who were willing and able to serve voluntarily in various capacities during the war. It was established at the request of the Commonwealth Department of Defence and the inaugural meeting was held on 14 March 1939 at the Brisbane City Hall with Major-General Sir Thomas Blamey, Chairman of the Man Power Board, in attendance. The Register originally operated under the Man Power Board and was financed by it with a grant of 300 pounds (\$600) per annum. On 25 November 1941 new rules and regulations were adopted after a proposal was made to set up a Women's War Work Council which would have overlapped the functions of the Women's Voluntary national Register. Rather than start a new organisation, it was decided to revitalise the Register.

By 1 May 1942 nearly 15,000 women had registered throughout Queensland and the register was supplying approximately 300 types a month plus workers for various patriotic purposes. Women were trained in canteens and emergency cooking involving two days practical cooking for large numbers of men in the military camps and lessons in butchering from camp butchers.

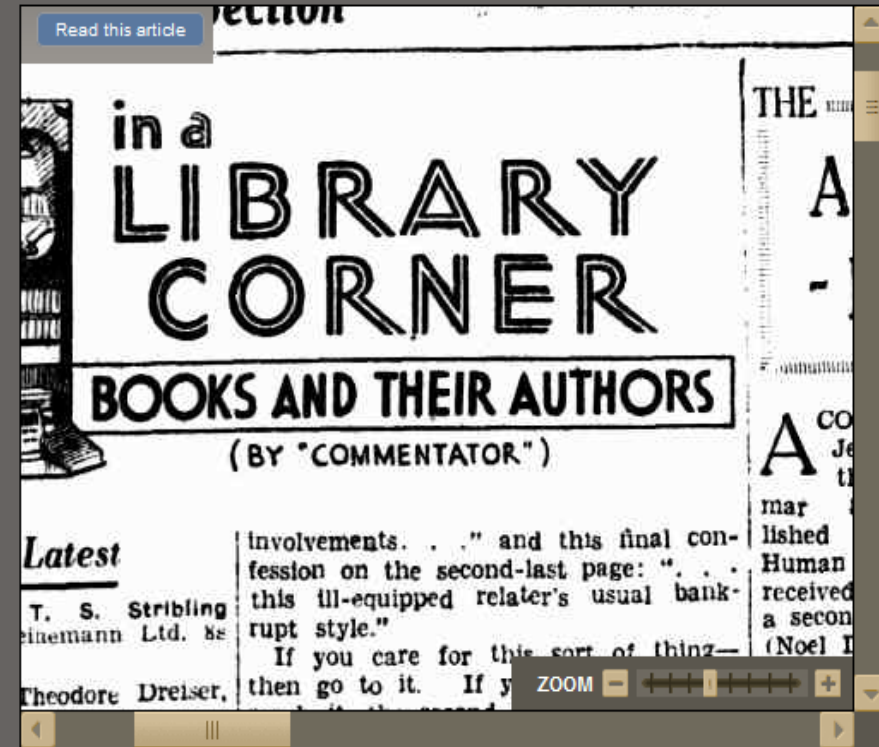

Why should I correct the electronically translated text?

Trove searches across the electronically translated text. Much of this text has not been translated accurately due to the poor quality of old newspapers. By correcting the electronically translated text, Trove is immediately able to retrieve better search results for users. Corrections should be made to match the text that was originally published (without formatting).

How do I correct the electronically translated text?

Correcting the electronically translated text refers to changing the text in the left hand column to match the text as it was originally printed. Text corrections are saved to the database and will improve the service for all users by increasing the accuracy of search results. Below are instructions for how to correct the text. We have further guidelines on the specific ways to fix the text [here](#).

Only the text as it appears can be changed. Changes that do not improve the accuracy of the text for searching (e.g. specifying formatting) are not currently supported.

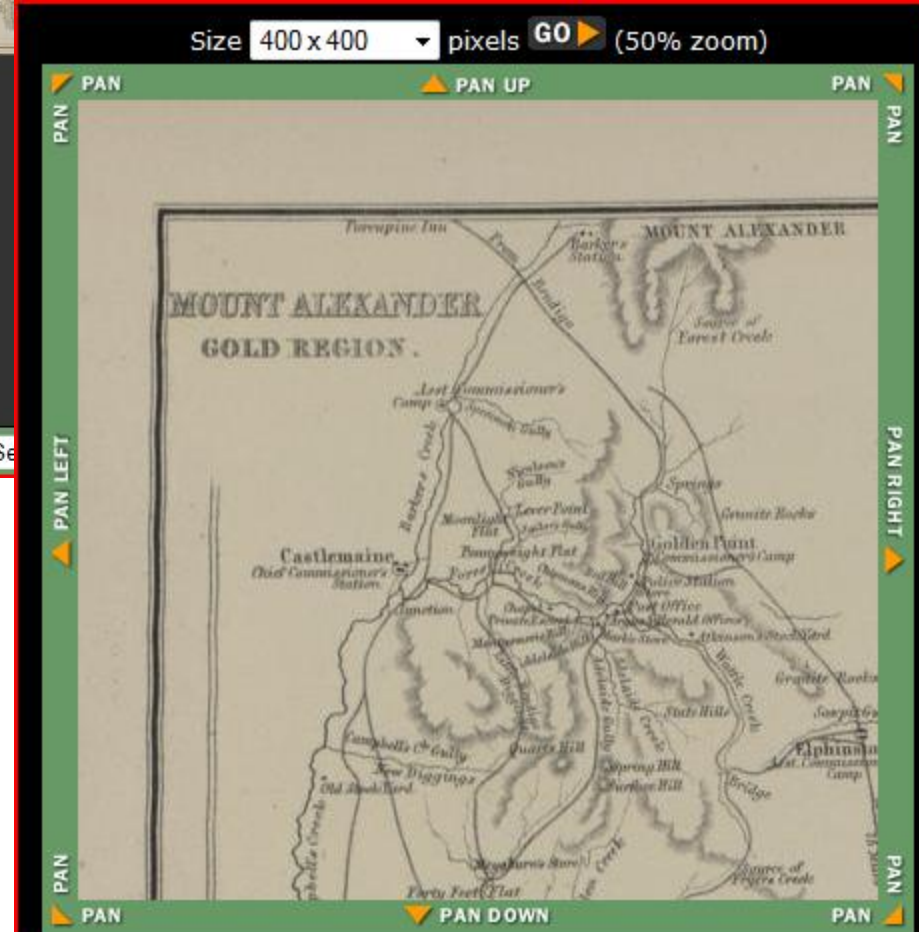

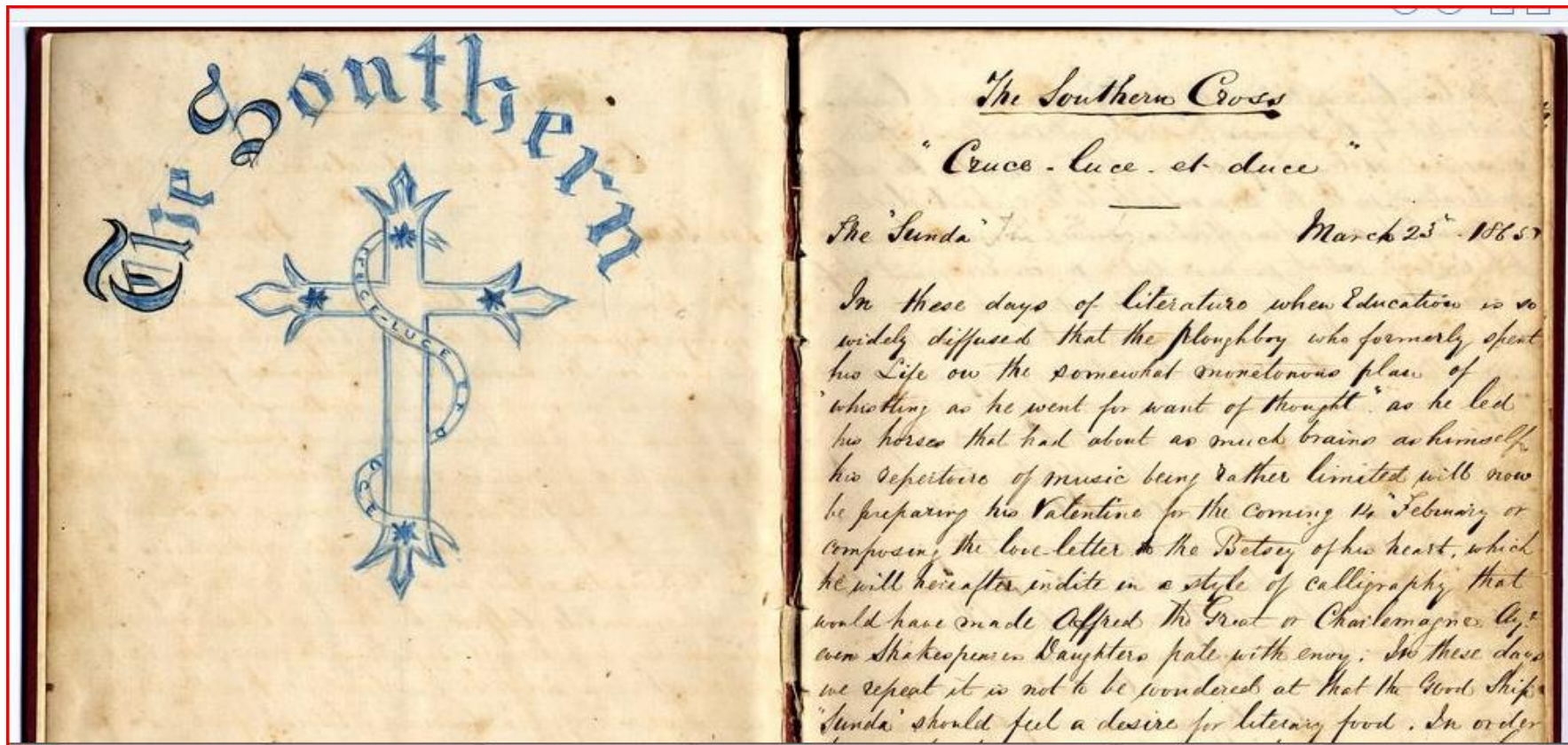
