

Starting your research

The Library's collections offer a wealth of resources to the Australian family historian.

You will find most family history material on microfiche and microfilm in a special area of the Newspapers and Microforms Reading Room. Check our guide to Family history sources in the Newspapers and Microforms Reading Room to see what we hold.

Staff can help you locate resources and use the microform equipment, but cannot do extensive or ongoing genealogical, historical or other research for you.

You can search the Library's catalogue for specific topics, such as published family histories, local histories, ship information and biography.

Check eResources for our many online resources relating to family history. Some of these you need to come to the Library's reading rooms to use.

Try both 'family history' and 'genealogy' when searching as both these terms are often used.

Frequently asked family history questions:

- How can the National Library of Australia help with my family history research?
- Where can I find information about Indigenous Australians?
- How can I get an Australian birth, death, or marriage certificate?





Descendents of Convicts' Group, Inc: Index to approximately 10,000 convict movements in the Colony of New South Wales (covering present day New South Wales, Queensland, Tasmania and Victoria. Entries comprise convict's names or alias, the date of the movement, and the place from which the convict was moved.

UNSW ADFA: This searchable database provides details on the 330,000 men and women who served overseas in the (First) Australian Imperial Force, 1914-1918. Information has been gathered from a variety of sources.

30. 🚳 Census of Ireland 1911

National Archives of Ireland: This site provides the household returns and ancilliary records of the 1911 census of Ireland. A name index, transcripts and digitised images are provided and you may also browse the census returns by street. Coverage for all counties is not yet complete.

14. K Eighteenth Century Journals: Newspapers and Periodicals 1685 - 1815

Adam Matthews: This service brings together rare journals printed between 1685 and 1815, illuminating all aspects of eighteenth-century social, political and literary life. Many are ephemeral, lasting only for a handful of issues, others run for several years. Topics covered are extremely wide-ranging and include: colonial life; provincial and rural affairs; the French and American revolutions; reviews of literature and fashion throughout Europe; political debates; and London coffee house gossip and discussion. The titles chosen have been screened carefully against other eighteenth century resources (many available at the National Library of Australia) to ensure minimal overlap. How do I correct the electronically translated text?

Correcting the electronically translated text refers to changing the text in the left hand column to match the text as it was originally printed. Text corrections are saved to the database and will improve the service for all users by increasing the accuracy of search results. Below are instructions for how to correct the text. We have further guidelines on the specific ways to fix the text here.

Only the text as it appears can be changed. Changes that do not improve the accuracy of the text for searching (e.g. specifying formatting) are not currently supported.
