

The Ryerson Index is an index to death notices appearing in current Australian newspapers. It also includes some funeral notices, probate notices and obituaries.

Because the Index was originally created by the Sydney Dead Persons Society, its strength lies in notices from NSW papers - including in excess of one million notices from the *Sydney Morning Herald* alone. However, the representation from papers from other states continues to grow, with additional papers being regularly added, so that the Index can now truly be considered an Australian index.

Indexing is being continuously carried out by a team of volunteers, too numerous to mention individually, who give freely of their time to ensure the site continues to grow. Site updates occur every couple of weeks, and more often in periods of high activity.

The index itself cannot by definition be considered a primary source of data, but is purely a research aid to direct the researcher to the original source of a notice.

## A Special Appeal to Family and Local History Societies

We always welcome Family History or Local History Societies who are interested in indexing the notices from their local paper. We find members of such societies make excellent indexers, because they know their local area and the names associated with it, and usually have a personal interest in the notices they are indexing.

CoraWeb - helping you trace your family history

[Trove Digitised Newspapers](#) offers free access to the full text of 636+ Australian newspaper titles dating from 1803 to 1954 (some later).

[Sydney Morning Herald Archives](#) with 820,000 pages from 13,000 issues 1st January 1955 to February 1995. The contents of all issues of the *Sydney Morning Herald* and *Sun Herald* are fully text searchable including advertisements, captions and birth, death and marriage notices. Full-text results are returned in an exact digital reproduction of the printed pages as they were originally published. Use the SMH archives in conjunction with the *Ryerson Index* to locate death notices. A variety of subscription options are available.

**Note:** This archive can be accessed for free from home using eResources. Libraries that currently have this archive as an eResource are the State Library of New South Wales, State Library of Victoria, State Library of South Australia and State Library of Western Australia. All you need is to do is apply online for a library card from your state library.

[Australian Periodical Publications \(1840-1845\)](#). This site, by the National Library of Australia, provides access to digital copies of Australian serials. Currently over 70 titles are available.





## QUEENSLAND GOVERNMENT EMIGRATION OFFICES, LONDON EMIGRATION TO QUEENSLAND. FREE GRANTS OF LAND.

A NEW EMIGRATION ACT, recently passed, entirely removes the restrictions as to age, which formerly required that men should be under 40 and women under 35. All persons paying their own full passages to the Colony will now receive a full £30 Land Order—equal to 30 Acres of Land, to be selected by themselves—for each member of their families counted as adults. Persons of twelve years and upwards are counted as adults; those between twelve months and twelve years are reckoned as children. Two children count as one adult. Children receive £15 Land Orders.

Free and Assisted Passages are now given to eligible persons without restriction as to age.






