## **SCHOOL ARCHIVES**

The Melbourne Grammar School Archives contains a unique collection of items that trace the history of the School from when it opened on the 7 April 1858 to the thriving community it is today.

Archived items are stored in a purpose-built facility at our St Kilda Road campus.

We present some of these items in our Archives Gallery, generally in a thematic manner. These displays often depict some of the most significant events in the life of the School over the past 160+ years. Visitors are welcome but only with an appointment.

#### **Real Estate Agencies**

UMA holds a number of collections which document the real estate industry both within Melbourne and the surrounding greater Melbourne area from the 1860s through to the 1960s. Primarily the records of estate agents operating during this period, these collections give an insight into this industry and the important role that it played in the development of Melbourne. 

#### ▼ Discover more about Victoria Outward Passenger Lists 1852-1915

This index contains the records of passengers who, between 1852 and 1915, embarked on journeys departing from Victoria and arriving in ports across Australia and around the world.

Passenger lists vary widely in size, length, and level of detail, as there was no standardised format. Some record only a minimum of information about the passengers, while others are quite detailed.

Note that some passengers were listed only under their surnames, or their first name initials, or as part of a family group (for example, 'Mr Jones and family'). Also, women, children, servants and passengers who travelled in steerage were sometimes not recorded on passenger lists.

Until 1871, assisted passenger lists were kept separately from unassisted passengers.

Assisted passengers Assisted passengers or migrants were those who migrated under sponsorship schemes, meaning their voyage was subsidised either fully or partially by the colonial government.

Unassisted passengers Unassisted passengers or migrants were those who paid their own fare or were privately sponsored. Prior to 1852, it was not required for the names of unassisted passengers to be recorded, making it difficult to assess how complete the existing passenger lists are.



#### What can these records tell me?

Each record includes a transcript. The amount of information listed varies, but the Victoria Outward Passenger Lists 1852-1915 usually include the following information about your ancestor:

- Name
- Age
- Estimated birth year
- Nationality
- Native place this is sometimes the place of birth, sometimes the last place of residence
- · Month and year of arrival
- Ship name
- Destination port
- Departure port

About Fremantle, Western Australia, Passenger Lists, 1897-1963

For most European ships, Fremantle, Western Australia, was the first port of call in Australia. This is a collection of passenger records of arrivals at Fremantle, Perth Airport, and other Western Australia ports. The lists, which are arranged chronologically, recorded passengers arriving from other Australian states and overseas and can include names of passengers passing through those ports en route to other ports within, and nearby ports outside, Australia.






