


The late Mr. JAMES BARNARD, who occupied the position of Government printer from 1839, till he retired on a pension in 1880, was appointed by the Imperial Government. He was born at

Hackney, London, in 1809, and died at Hobart on the 20th April, 1897, having attained the ripe age of eighty-nine years. On his arrival in Hobart on

fifty-eight years of married life, died on the 21st of December, 1898, in the eighty-fifth year of her age. There have been five children of the marriage—Mr. D. M. Barnard, formerly a merchant in Launceston; a daughter, now Mrs. Rouse, of Guntawong Station, near Mudgee, N.S.W.; Mr. Henry S. Barnard (deceased); James Barnard, the present Collector of Customs; and Dr. Charles Barnard, of Macquarie Street.

Mr. JOHN GIBSON MCGREGOR is one of the few old colonists now remaining, whose lives are linked with the early history of Tasmania. Mr.



of his business, which was taken over by Mr. J. G. McGregor, who carried it on for about twenty years, when he retired into private life. The principal vessels built by Mr. J. G. McGregor were the "Petrel," the "Hally Bayley," "Harriet McGregor," and "Loongana," which were all well and favourably known, either in the intercolonial or London trade. Mr. McGregor is a director of the Derwent and Tamar Insurance Company, a position he has held for many years. He has resided on Battery Point for over fifty years, and has lived in his present residence, "Hill Crest," for twenty-seven years. Mr. McGregor has a family of two sons and two daughters. The sons are now carrying on business as merchants, under the style of McGregor Bros., 12 Elizabeth Street, Hobart.

The late Mr. FREDERICK HENRY WISE, of "Riawena," Battery Point, Hobart, was one of the long list of victims to the influenza scourge, which raged in various parts of the island during the latter part of 1899.

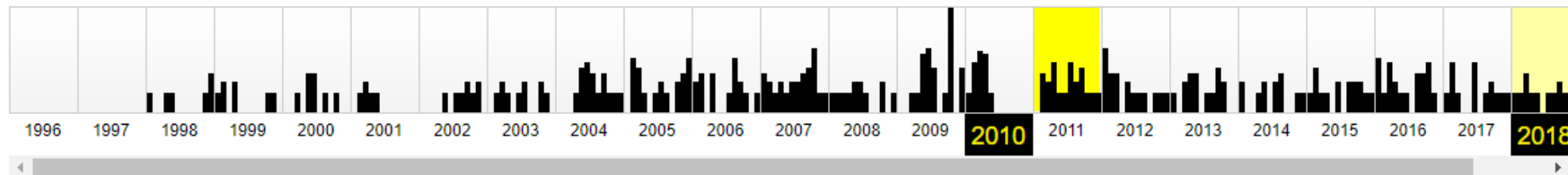

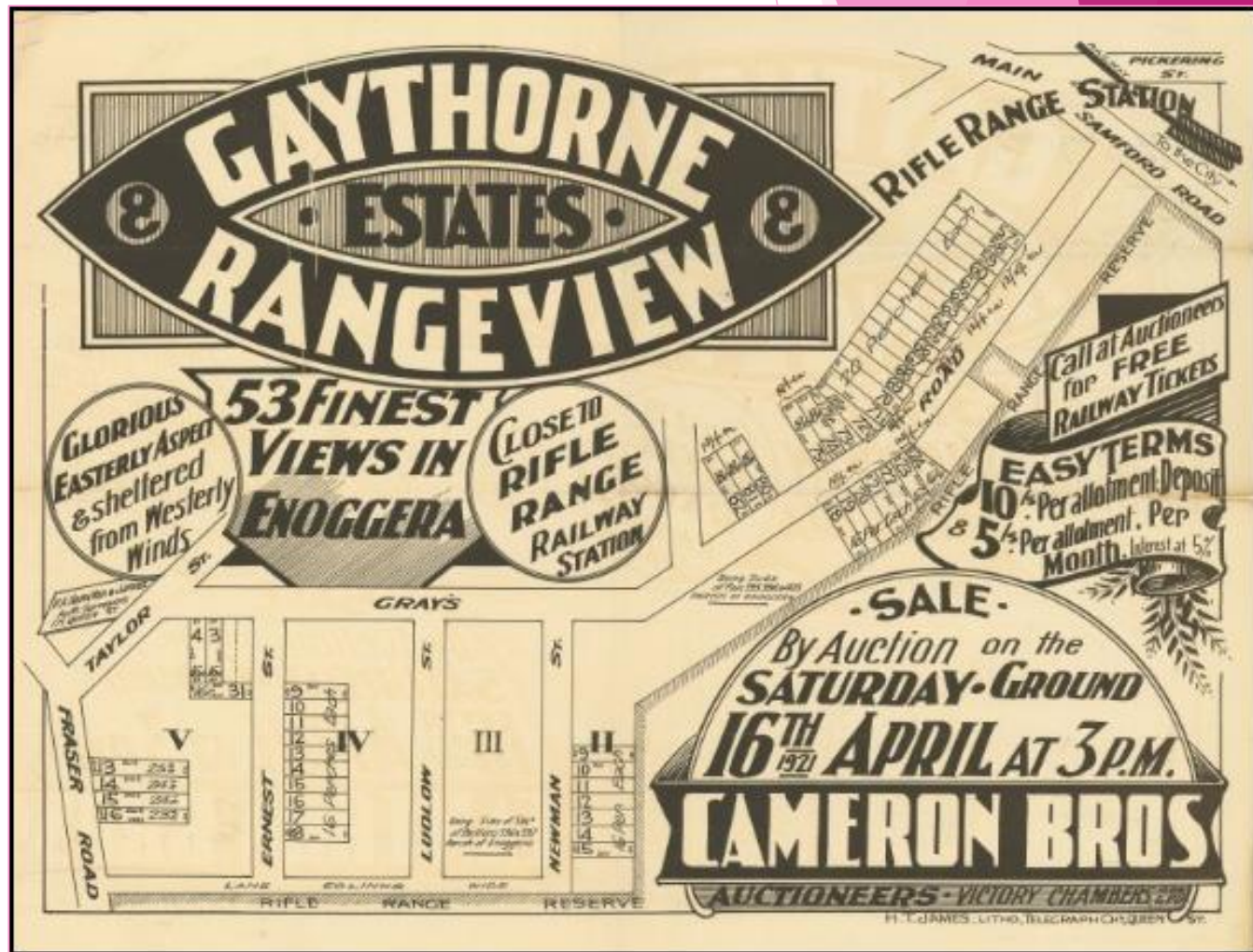

Tiffin (1 p.m.): Jacket potatoes, cold ham, cold corned beef, salmon, cold lamb and mint sauce, cold fowl and tongue, salad, fruit, biscuits, &c. Dinner (7 p.m.): Mock turtle and gravy soups; entrees—chicken cutlets, ragout oxtail; joints—roast sirloin of beef and Yorkshire pudding, boiled turkey and oyster sauce, roast goose, roast mutton and red currant jelly, curry, brawn; sweets—blackcap pudding, tipsy cake, fruity jellies, Victoria sandwiches, tartlets, ices; dessert; coffee. Thus for the saloon, and now for the second-class—Breakfast (8 a.m.): Mutton chops, cutlets, Irish stew, hashed duck, curry and rice, potatoes, toast, jams and marmalades, tea and coffee. Dinner (1 p.m.): Oxtail soup, roast steak and kidney pie, mutton and caper sauce, roast beef, baked and boiled potatoes, curry and rice; sweets—sago pudding, fruit pie, jam tartlets; dessert. Tea (5.30 p.m.): Fish, cold meats, preserves, biscuits. None but a fidgety old maid or snarling selfish old bachelor could take exception to the accommodation set apart for second-class passengers, taking the Chyebassa as an average boat, and none but individuals whose digestive organs were at odds with food of every kind would sneeze at the meals provided.

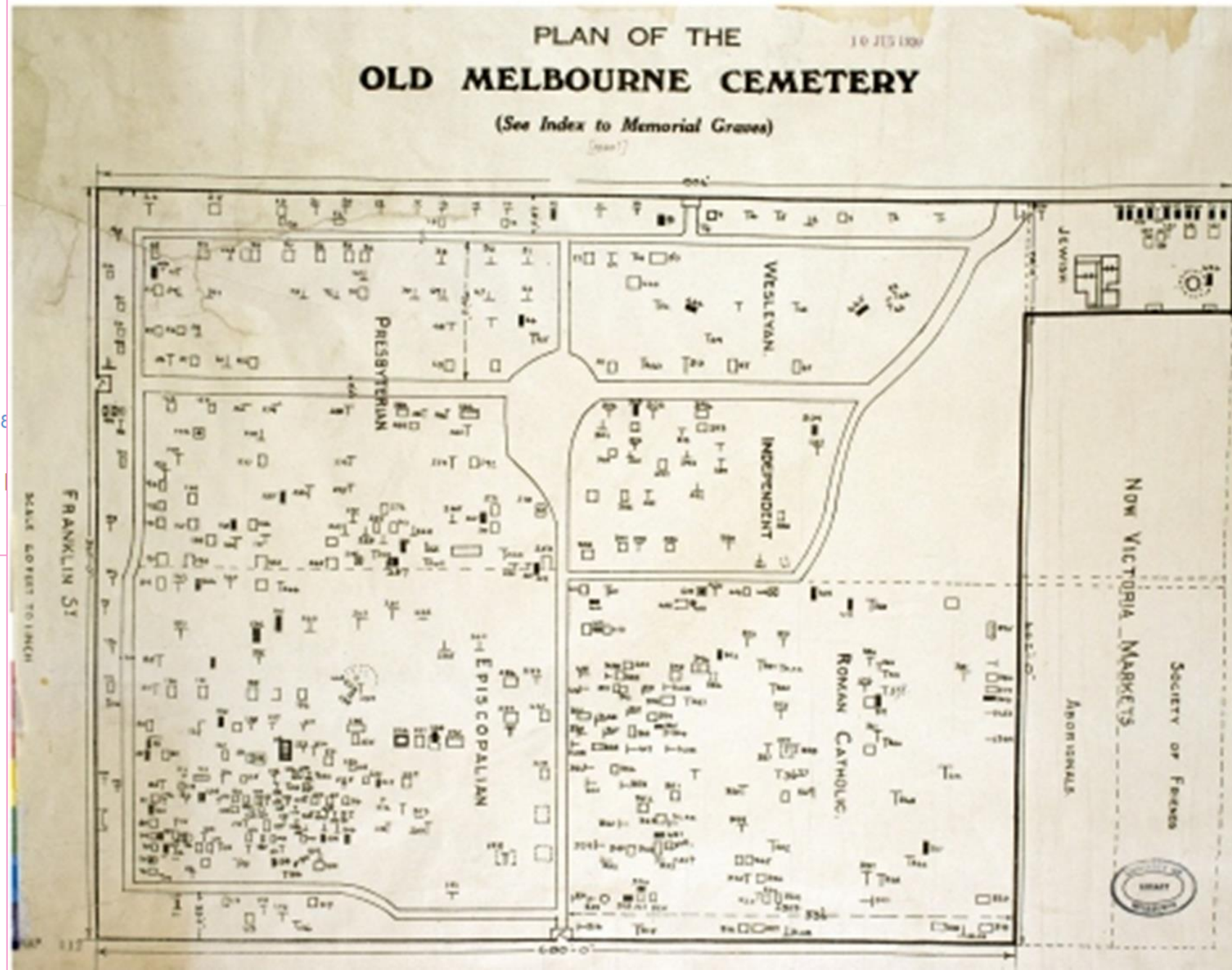

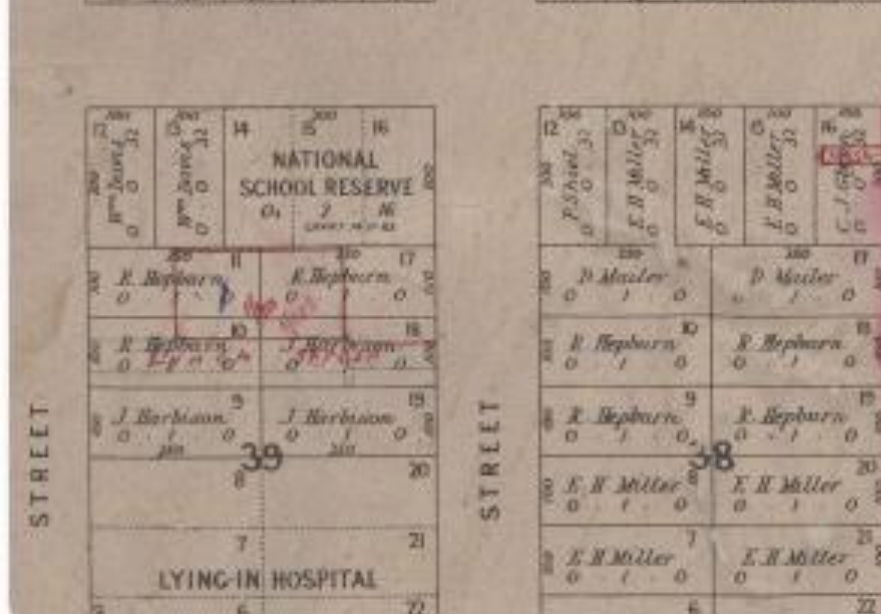

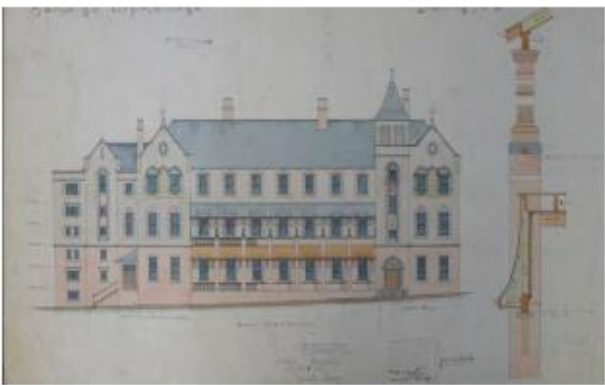

The Boys' Home was established in April 1890 in the South Brisbane home of Mr and Mrs Thompson. It was run by a Committee of private citizens. In late 1897 it moved to a property named 'Rowallan' at 84 Kedron Park Road, Woolloowin. In 1906, under Canon EC Osborn, the home moved to a nine-acre property at Hurdcliffe Street, Enoggera and changed its name to Enoggera Boys' Home.

The Boys' Home was opened in April 1890 by Mr and Mrs Thompson in their own home in Stanley Street, South Brisbane. It was maintained by private subscriptions and donations of food, clothing and furniture. Mr James Ferguson (of Messrs Watson and Ferguson, booksellers) acted as honorary Secretary and Treasurer of the home. He also acted as trustee for most boys when they left the home to take up employment. The boys' employers forwarded their wages to Ferguson who deposited the wages in their Savings Bank Accounts.

These volumes were verified as missing from the State Archives Collection & we accepted them from the Society in January.

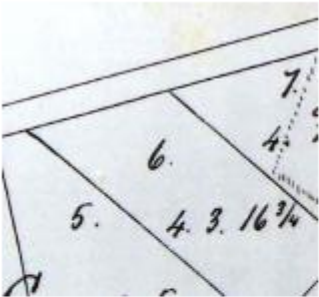
This is an exciting accession into the Collection & a strong testament to the knowledge & engagement of our partners. We are very grateful to the Society for their strong support of our work & purpose.

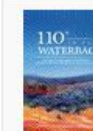
