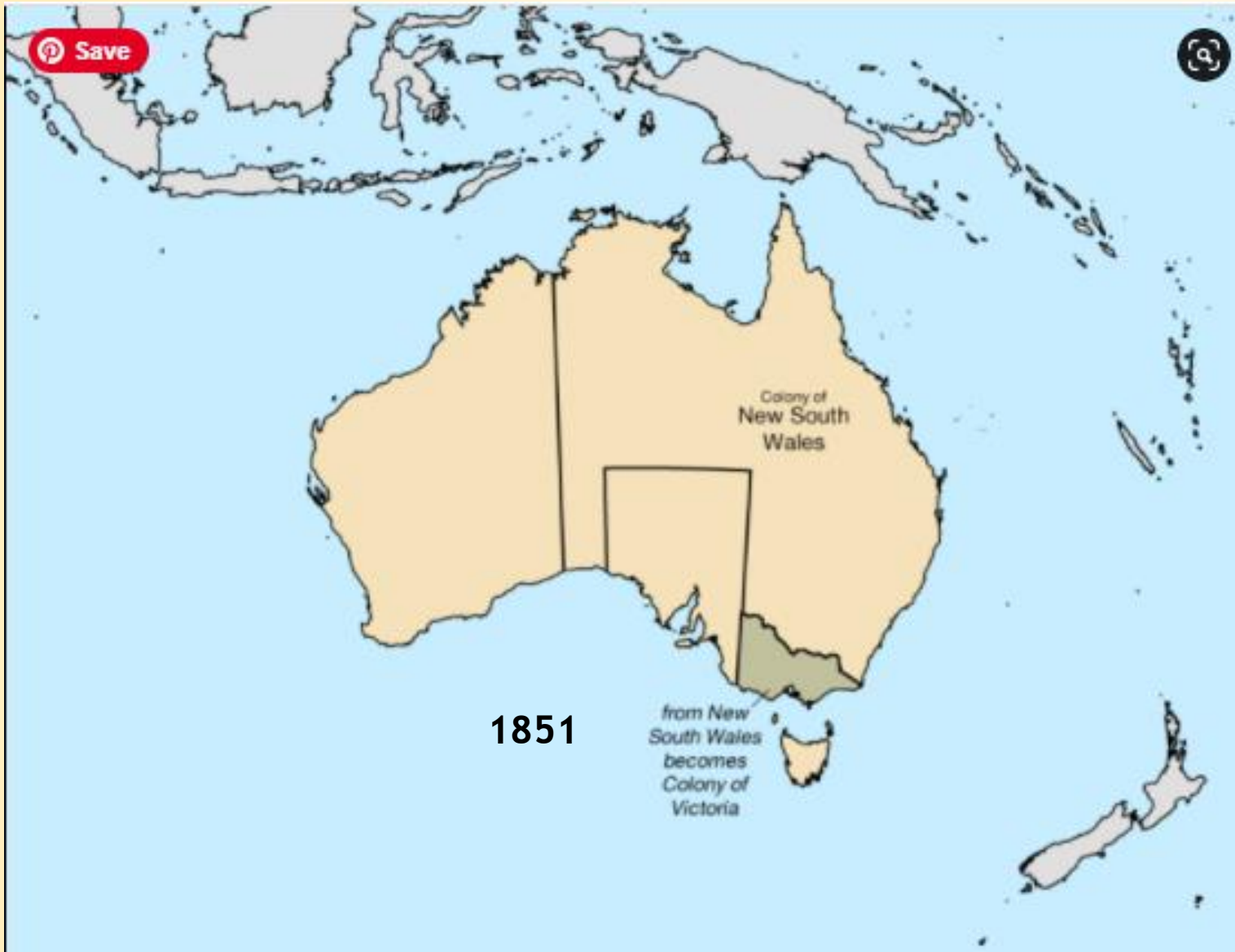

- ▶ Australia is a huge country.
Consider geographic distance
- ▶ Must know place and time - no
central recordkeeping
- ▶ Place names have changed,
especially after each World War
- ▶ Use all variants for surnames -
with most archives spelling must
be specific!

The CHSI Collection is a mostly paper-based archive relating to the history of Castlemaine and the former Mount Alexander goldfields district.
